### A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF CERTAIN STATUTES RELATING TO RODENT PEST CONTROL.

### **Bill Summary**

**Joint Budget Committee.** Effective July 1, 2025, the bill repeals certain statutes relating to rodent pest control.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

1	<b>SECTION 1.</b> In Colorado Revised Statutes, <b>add</b> 35-7-118 as
2	follows:
3	<b>35-7-118.</b> Repeal of part. This part 1 is repealed, effective
4	JULY 1, 2025.
5	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly finds,
6	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
7	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
8	the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
9	institutions.
